## Nanaimo Quilters Guild Meeting Minutes January 17, 2007

Meeting called to order at 1 p.m. by Shirley. Four visitors were introduced and welcomed - all of whom joined the Guild today. Welcome ladies.

**Treasurer's Report:** We made a profit of \$1891.25 on the cookbooks. Combined total funds in the Guild \$17,660.16. **Treasurer's report moved by Norma, seconded by Avril. Carried.**

### Committee Reports:

**Quilt Show:** everything in order. \$1200 received from Nanaimo Parks & Rec. February's program will be geared to the Quilt Show. 5" or 6" squares still needed for the 'Quilter's Candy' to be distributed to shops. They will be folded in February. Raffle tickets are ready but cannot be sold until after January 28, 2007 - \$2 each - 20 tickets to a book.

**Comfort Quilts:** 36 quilts were distributed to 5 centers for a total value of \$2340.

**Boutique:** Please start making small things (baby things, kitchen, Christmas) for the boutique - 15% of price comes back to Guild. We would like get Visa/Mastercard for the Guild. Total cost per

year would be \$240.

**Moved by Nadine, seconded by Avril that the Guild apply for a Visa/Mastercard. Carried.**

**Challenge:** Kathy has only 2 kits left.

**Quilt Bee:** Need extra teams. Goal is 36 quilts this year. Bingo Cards (from the Christmas pot luck) will be made into quilts at the Bee.

**Program:** 2 or 3 spaces still available for the spring workshops. The November retreat was cancelled due to bad weather. Six spaces left for the February one. We must have at least 30 to make it a go. CGA show in Kamloops - May 2-5. ETA's prices are: double \$395.00; Quad \$365. Accommodation will be in dorms. Contact ETA directly.

### New Business:

Shirley read a couple of thank you letters. 25 metres of fabric was purchased and cut and packaged into fat quarters to be sent to the CQA show in Kamloops. Val Ursulak will send them on.

The Newcomers' Tea on January 22 was cancelled but will be rescheduled

Maia wants pictures of any Guild events  
Sasha explained the need for a laptop computer for the library and other Guild programmes. Possible cost \$1,500 - \$2,500. Our library is valued at approximately \$30,000. A committee was struck to explore the possibility. Volunteers for the committee are Val Ursulak, Cathy Calder, Maggie Brown, Barbara Clement and Sasha. Time line set for April meeting as Sasha will be away until then.

Eimear Keane will check out insurance for our library and other equipment the Guild owns.

Following our meeting Judy Farrow presented a very enjoyable trunk show of her many works along with interesting stories. (more photos on page 5)

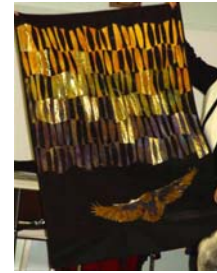

Quilt Show Report

A Summary of the January 3 Quilt Show Meeting Minutes

**Meet the Artist:** We will encourage those people who have submitted quilts for the show to attend Sunday May 27, 1-3 pm.

**Challenge Quilts:** Voting will be done by guild members at the May guild meeting.

**Junior Fiber Arts:** Pat will send 2<sup>nd</sup> notices to remind schools. She will have special entry forms for this category.

**Lunch Room:** Committee may obtain assistance from high school students. Menu is set, and they are negotiating to borrow, rather than rent dishes.

**Past Presidents Award:** Val has a list of 12 past presidents. As this is an award for a traditional style quilt, there will be a second category; original, contemporary fibre art – titled Show Committee Award. There will be 30 ballots handed out to members of the show committee at the last meeting before the show.

**Photo Curator:** Maia would like many photos of guild events.

**Quilt Tags:** Avril will take photos to be printed on the quilt tags with the information from the call for entry.

**Raffle:** Ticket sales will start January 28.

**Volunteers:** Bonnie will have sign up forms for volunteers at the February guild meeting.

**Sleeves on Quilts:** Sleeves will be required on all quilts entered in the show. At the February guild meeting, Coreen will advise membership and Avril will have some samples of sleeves to show.

**Merchants Mall:** The merchants participating in our merchant mall will be printed in the newsletter.

**CD of quilt photos:** Avril suggested that the guild arrange to have CD made with photos of all the quilts in the show. Coreen advises that Parksville has made about \$1800 from sale of their CD's.

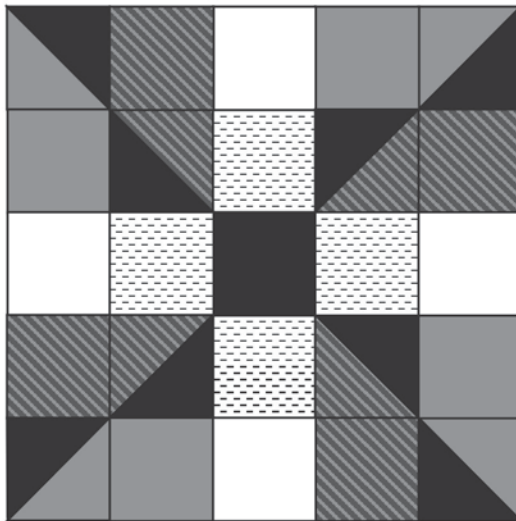

This year the Scrappy Bags satellite group has chosen a twisty theme to all of the patterns. As well, each of the blocks will have some black. All colours will change when compared to each other so ensure you are pleased with your fabric choices together. This time around all of the blocks will be **15" finished**. As there are 12 blocks per year, including the summer, simply using sashing will provide a 3 block X 4 block sampler quilt, big enough for a single bed!

*\*Note: to help all participants' blocks to wind up the same finished measurement, all seams will be a **scant 1/4"**. Also, any triangles must be pressed flat but gently to avoid stretching.*

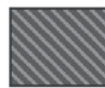
### NQG Block of the Month - March 2007



Another simple yet effective block, composed of several half-square triangles. Just take your time and follow along one step at a time.



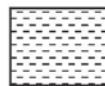
Black on black or plain black: cut 4 squares 4" each  
cut 1 square 3 1/2"



Red print or tone on tone: cut 4 squares 3 1/2" each  
cut 2 squares 4"



Blue print or tone on tone: cut 4 squares 3 1/2" each  
cut 2 squares 4"



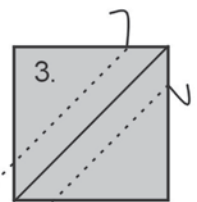
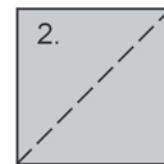
Yellow: cut 4 squares 3 1/2" each



White on white: cut 4 squares 3 1/2" each

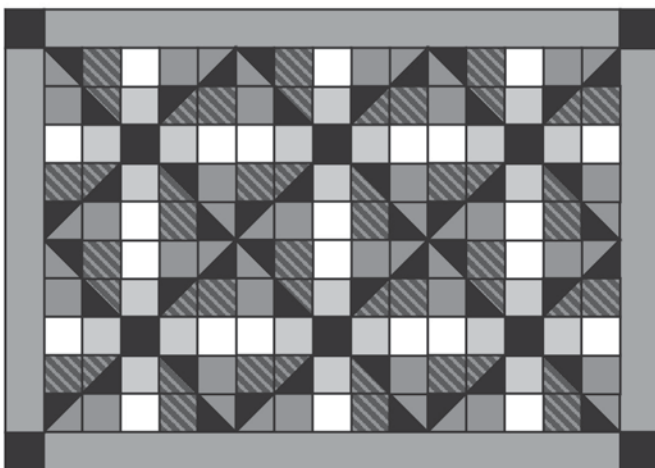
#### Half square triangles

1. Pair the 4" black squares with the reds and blues color.
2. On the back of the colored square of each set draw a pencil line diagonally from one corner to another.
3. Sew a **scant 1/4"** from each side of your drawn line.
4. Cut on the drawn line and gently press each half-square triangle open.
5. Square up each half square triangle to 3 1/2".



#### Completing your block

6. Piece the half square triangles and the other bits as in the diagram above, using scant 1/4" seams. Notice the areas of matching, being careful of the rotations.
7. Square your block up to **15 1/2"**.
